INT: OPEN IN MARY'S OFFICE, PHONE RINGS, SHE PICKS UP

MARY

Hello, this is Rover Rescue, how can I help you?

INT OF RYAN'S HOME, HE'S ON HIS PHONE

RYAN

Hi, I'm interested in getting a dog, now that I work from home but I don't really know that much about them; I've only seen them on TV.

REST OF SHOTS CUT BACK AND FORTH BETWEEN MARY AND RYAN TALKING

MARY

That's OK, lots of first-time owners have little to no experience. What kind of dog are you interested in?

RYAN

I was hoping to get something big, almost my size. Maybe it could speak a little English. Also, I'm really into weed, so a dog that's OK with that would be great.

MARY

(beat) Sir, I believe you're describing Scooby Doo.

RYAN

Yea, like I said, I've only seen dogs on TV.

MARY

I'm not sure you have a realistic picture of what dogs are.

RYAN

Ok, ok. So, I saw this dog once that could drive. He had a Prius because he said he was saving the environment but I think he was just being a dick.

MARY That's Brian from Family Guy. RYAN

The cool thing about that dog is he could make martinis. Mind you, he used vodka instead of gin but I bet I could teach him to make a proper martini.

MARY

Again, Brian from Family Guy. Not real.

#### RYAN

That dog also wrote a book, so there's that.

#### MARY

Man you watch a lot of Family Guy.

#### RYAN

Holy crap, I just remembered - one Christmas my dad brought home a dog. We were all really pissed because we didn't have any presents but when my dad came home with that dog, all was forgiven.

#### MARY

That's Santa's Little Helper, from The Simpson's He's thirty years old now.

## RYAN

That reminds me, I saw this poor dog once who had to sleep on top of his doghouse because he was way too big to fit inside. I don't want a dog that size.

## MARY

Now you're mixing Snoopy with Marmaduke. I can't even imagine how the breeders would make that work.

# RYAN

Last week, I saw a dog that smoked a cigar and was very disrespectful to authority. He was very rude to a bunch of people he talked to.

#### MARY

That's Triumph the insult comic dog and it's not even a dog, it's a puppet. Did you notice he didn't have any arms?

## RYAN

I just thought it was part of his breed, you know, like how some dogs can play basketball yet don't seem to understand a zone defense.

## MARY HANGS HER HEAD

# RYAN (CONT'D)

I did see this one dog that ate pasta as a meal and hated Mondays. I don't like Monday's either but feeding a dog pasta everyday seems wrong.

# MARY

That's actually a cat, Garfield. There was a dog in that series, so maybe you should have gone in that direction instead.

## RYAN

OK, what about one of those small blue ones that live in a mushrooms.

MARY

Those are smurfs.

### RYAN

(beat, sighs) I thought I knew at least something about dogs but I guess not. I guess I just suck.

#### MARY

Look, a dog might not be right for you today but if you stop and think about it, you do have a good idea of what you want.

# MARY (CONT'D)

You want a dog that's as loyal as Scooby, as loving as Santa's Little Helper and as athletic as Air Bud. Just leave out the Brian from Family Guy parts.

RYAN

But I really like that show.

# MARY

Yea, I can tell. (beat) Here's my advice - Get out of your house and go to park or to the pet food store. Go see how real dogs act and what they're like. I bet if you spend some quality time around dogs, you'll be ready adopt soon. RYAN Thanks, I'll do that. I do have one last question. MARY Sure, what? RYAN Are dogs really god, just spelled backwards? MARY Have a good day sir. End
