

Home Burglary in Lisle

Lisle Police responded to a reported burglary Monday at a residence on Main street. The homeowner, whose identity was undisclosed, reported over \$10,000 in drums were taken.

No injuries or confrontations were reported during the incident, according to a Lisle Police report.

The unidentified suspect gained entry to the residence through an unlocked window, bypassing the standard security measures, according to the report. The individual made a swift and calculated entry, leaving no immediate evidence of forced entry.

Upon gaining access, the suspect ransacked the premises, methodically going through various rooms and personal belongings. According to the report, valuables and electronics were not targeted, only the musical instruments were taken.

Lisle Police were alerted to the situation when a neighbor noticed unusual activity at the residence and promptly reported it to the police. The suspect fled before authorities arrived.
